
How a child reacts to their parent's separation will depend on age, level of emotional development, attachment or relationship history and, most importantly, how respectful the parents are towards one another.

Parenting After Separation is a free 6 hour workshop that can help parents understand how to meet their child's needs during this difficult time.

This workshop will also help parents in understanding the process and effects of separation and will encourage parents to make positive choices about how they will continue to parent their children after separation.

The objectives of Parenting After Separation are to provide parents with tools to:

- help children through the separation
- help parents maintain a positive relationship with their children
- help parents understand the emotional, financial and legal implications of divorce or separation
- assist parents in preparing a parenting plan, and
- promote mediation as a means of resolving disputes



#### Additional information:

- parents must attend the entire 6 hour course to receive a certificate.
- parents may ask to attend together or apart.
- attendance is required for most proceedings in the Court of Queen's Bench.
- attendance is voluntary for Provincial Court matters unless ordered by the court.
- no children will be admitted.
- security is on site.

# Parenting After Separation for Families in High Conflict (PASHC)

The more intense, long-lasting and open the conflict between the parents during their separation, the more problems the children experience. Children often respond to parental conflict with aggressive behaviour, depression and other behaviour problems.

In some instances, a high level of conflict may continue for several years after separation. Families experiencing high conflict may routinely find themselves in court to solve issues that should be relatively simple.

PASHC is a free 3 hour seminar available to all parents who have already completed the 6 hour Parenting After Separation course. PASHC is presently available in Edmonton and Calgary areas only.

### Course topics include:

- Separating Partner and Parental Roles
- Parenting Plan for High Conflict Families
- Anger, Abuse, Power and Control
- Child Development and the Needs of Children
- Renegotiating Boundaries
